

Live Scam Free! 6 Useful Tips for Older Adults

Gift cards are for gifts, not payment!

Scammers often ask for gift cards as a form of payment. Do not provide access codes or pictures of gift cards to anyone.



Cash and cryptocurrency are untraceable. If you give it to the wrong person, you will never get it back.

Never send large sums of cash in the mail.

Caller ID on the phone cannot be trusted.



Phone numbers can be mimicked and may be part of the scam.



Protect your personal & financial information.

Whether through a phone call, text message, e-mail or online, do not give your private data to anyone if you did not initiate contact.

Do not allow or use remote access to electronic devices.

While this can be a useful tool, best practice is simple: do not allow it.



Federal agencies will never call you. Hang up! It's a scam.
